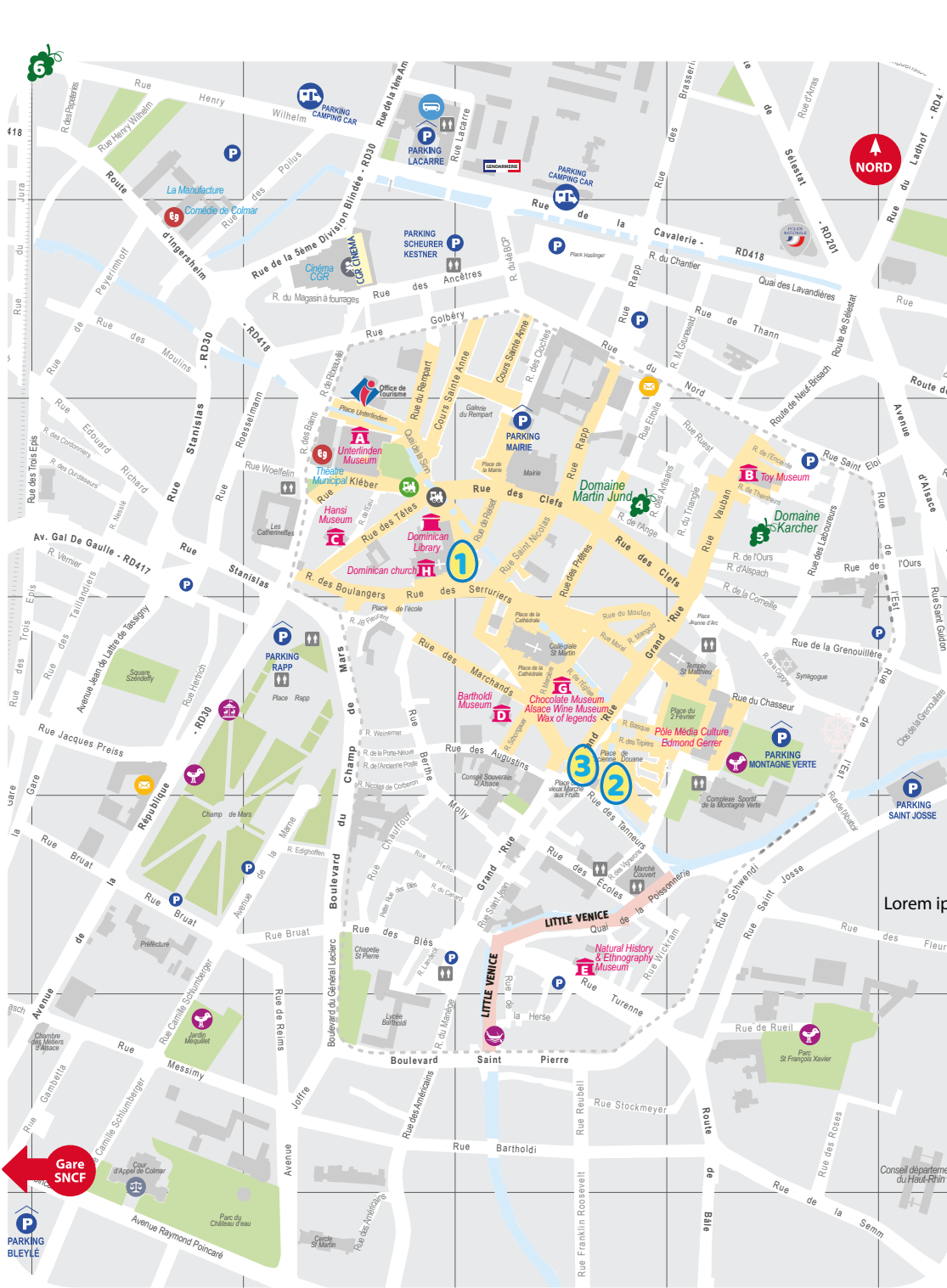

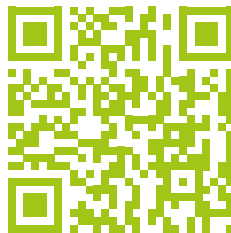

Since time immemorial, eggs have symbolised the renewal of life and the return of spring. In the Christian era, they became associated with Easter and rebirth. Discover the techniques used by egg miniaturists to embellish their creations, drawing on traditions from Eastern European countries: painting, calligraphy, scratching, perforation, batik, and more.

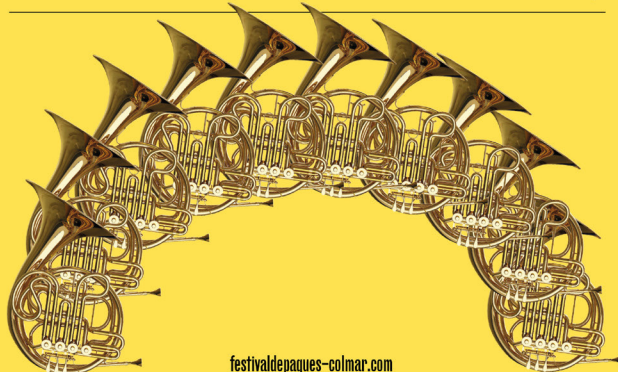
